Sun Sugar Hybrid

This very productive orange cherry tomato has highly sweet flavor with fruity overtones, with a thin skin that is very crack resistant. Plants are vigorous and disease resistant.

Indeterminate - 62 days



Green Zebra Heirloom Tomato

Beautiful chartreuse with deep lime-green stripes. Flesh is bright green and very rich tasting, sweet and

juicy with a bit of a sharp bite to it. Excellent yield. Around 3 oz. *Indeterminate - 75 days*



Jasper Hybrid Cherry Tomato

Sweet and rich, pleasantly chewy, small red cherry tomato is flavorful, and crack resistant, with late blight resistance. Productive and easy to grow.

Indeterminate - 60 days



Ruth's Perfect Heirloom Tomato

Tall, strong, vigorous plants produce beautifully spherical, deep-red, half-pound salad tomatoes with a distinctive, delicious fruity flavor. Keeps well

after picking. *Indeterminate - 78 days*



Chiapas Heirloom Currant Cherry Tomato

Chiapas is vigorous, very productive, flavorful, early and disease resistant. A more wild relative of tomato, it's resistant

to many diseases including Late Blight, Early Blight and Septoria. *Indeterminate - 55 days*



Chocolate Stripes Heirloom Tomato

Plants yield a plentiful crop of large, mahogany colored fruit with olive green-striping and delicious, complex, rich, sweet flavor.

Indeterminate - 79 days



Jaune de Flamme Heirloom Tomato

This French heirloom produces high yields of 2-4 oz orange, juicy, flavorful tomatoes. They have a perfect blend of sweet and

tart. Perfect for salads, salsas, and sauces. Low acidity variety. *Indeterminate - 75 days*



Ten Fingers of Naples Heirloom Paste Tomato

Rich, meaty and delicious! We prefer Ten Fingers of Naples over San Marzano for its rich flavor and

disease resistance. Its long trusses (often numbering ten, hence the name) of meaty fruits with few seeds make salsa and sauce making a dream. Some Late Blight resistance. *Indeterminate - 75 days*



Pink Berkeley Beefsteak Tomato

Unique appearance with heirloom-quality flavor. 8-16 oz. fruits are dark pink with green striping, with pink and yellow streaked flesh. The

flavor is outstanding - sweet and complex like the finest heirlooms. The *compact indeterminate* plants performs much better than average under disease pressure. *70 days*



Mountain Magic Hybrid Tomato

Excellent flavor and late blight resistant! Mountain Magic produces high yields of 2 oz., bright red, round

salad tomatoes with very sweet flavor. The uniform, crack-resistant fruits may be truss harvested. Great in salads or right off the vine. High resistance to fusarium wilt races 0-2, late blight, and verticillium wilt; and intermediate resistance to early blight. *Compact Indeterminate - 69 days*



Gilbertie Paste Heirloom Tomato

Rich, meaty and delicious!

Long, slender shape with characteristically green shoulders and a slight crook

in the neck. Narrow, 10-12 oz fruits average 7" long with very solid, rich-flavored flesh that makes excellent sauces and soups. Very small seed cavity. *Indeterminate -85 days*



Cisneros Grande Heirloom Tomatillo

Large fruits, up to 2½ in., make for easy harvesting and processing. Highly productive. Most fruits

ripen to yellow, while some stay green throughout. For a tarter salsa, use the bright green fruits while the husk is still green; for a sweet and fruity flavor, wait until the husk fades. 4-6 ft. plants. *85 days.*
