Heritage Cherry Tomato **Blueberries**

Stunning, blue-black, cherry tomato with high levels of antioxidants. Highly productive, disease and crack resistant with a balance of meaty and sweet flavor. Ripe when bottom turns red. Great for salads and salsas. Indeterminant. 75 days. 25 seeds



Heritage Tomato **Brad's Atomic Grape**

This is a delicious, sweet, productive tomato growing in clusters, with a plum shape. The color ranges from purple to green to red/brown with blue stripes. It holds well on the vine & after harvest. Indeterminate 75 Days. 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomato **Chadwick's Cherry**

Tall, strong vigorous plants produce clusters of mouth watering 1" cherry tomatoes. Highly productive and disease resistant. A wonderful heirloom. Indeterminate. 80 Days. 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomato **Chocolate Stripes**

Tomato plants yield a plentiful crop of 3-4 inch, flattened, mahogany colored fruit with dark, olive-green striping and a delicious, complex, rich, sweet, earthy flavor. Indeterminate. 79 Days. 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomato **Gilbertie Paste**

Long, slender, 7" heirloom fruits have rich flavored, meaty flesh and make excellent sauces and soups. Small seed cavity. Indeterminate 85 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomato **Orange Banana**

Productive, heirloom with clusters of orange, cylindrical fruits, 3-4" long by 1-2" wide. They are sweet and very flavorful. Perfect for salads, salsas and sauces. Great drying variety. Disease resistant. Indeterminate. 85 days. 25 seeds



Shell or Dry Beans

True Cranberry Pole

This heirloom pole bean is a dependable producer of round, deep red beans that look like a ripe cranberry and have a rich, full-bodied flavor. Use at the shellingstage or dried. Grows to 6'. 105 days to dried. 80 seeds



Scarlet Emperor **Runner Beans**

Growing to 6 feet, this 1735 heirloom pole bean, bears showy sprays of bright scarlet flowers loved by hummingbirds, followed by loads of slender pods about 8" long. Young pods can be used as snap beans, allowed to mature for a fresh shell bean, or dried for winter soups. 50-60 days. 20 seeds



Native Heritage Popcorn

Early Pink Pearl

This is an early maturing, heirloom corn, refined in Oregon. It averages 2, 5-6", pearly-pink to mauve ears per 5-6' stalk. It makes yummy popcorn, beautiful fall decorations, and can be ground for cornmeal. 90 Days. 100 seeds



Native Heritage Popcorn

Glass Gem

This native popcorn comes in an endless range of colors. Translucent kernels shine brilliantly like glass! The 5-8" ears are very decorative and delicious as well for popcorn and cornmeal. Sturdy plants can reach to 9'. 110 Days. 100 seeds



Native Heritage Corn

Painted Mountain

This vigorous, early, high yielding, native corn grows to 6' and produces 7-8", beautiful ears. Great for fall decorations and eating! It can be eaten fresh, roasted or dried and ground into cornmeal. It matures well in zone 4. 85 Days. 100 seeds



Shelling Peas

Miragreen

4-5" pods with 8-10 plump, sweet peas. 4 foot productive vines. Hard to find heirloom variety being maintained at Frosty Morning Farm for many years. 68 days 80 seeds



Snow Peas

Schweizer Riesen

4-5" sweet, crunchy pods on productive 5-6' vines. Eat the whole thing! This Swiss heirloom really cranks out the snow peas! Good raw or lightly cooked. 70 Days 80 seeds



Snap Peas

Sugar Snap

3" sweet, crunchy pods. Eat the whole thing! 5-6 foot productive vines. This is the original Sugar Snap, and is still the best! Best when they fatten up-68 Days. 80 seeds



Snow Peas

Blizzard

Concentrated, high yields of slender, neon-green, 3" pods on 3 1/2' vines. Sweet, crisp and easy to pick. Blizzard is great in salads, stir-fries or eaten fresh off the vine. 61 Days. 80 seeds



Zucchini

Costata Romanesco

A sought after Italian heirloom, with gray-green skin and fluted edges. Flavor is rich, sweet and nutty. Much better flavor than hybrids. Excellent raw or cooked. Harvest small for best texture, but still delicious when bigger. Big, sprawling plant. 60 Days 20 seeds



Heritage Tomato

Flaming Burst Pear/Cherry

Plants are loaded with 1 oz, split resistant, sweet, juicy fruit. From the breeder of Green Zebra. Compact indeterminate. 70 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomato

Persimmon

Heirloom grown by Thomas Jefferson in 1781. Productive plant produces beautiful orange, 14-16 oz., meaty, juicy tomatoes with few seeds and sweet fruity flavors. Great for eating fresh, slicing for salads and sandwiches. Crack resistant. Indeterminate. 80 days 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomato

Ruth's Perfect

Tall, strong, vigorous plants produce beautifully spherical, deep-red, 1/2 pound salad tomatoes with a delicious, fruity flavor. Keeps well after picking. Indeterminate. 78 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomato

Sungella

2" wide orange globes with deliciously sweet flesh. Very productive and cold tolerant. Bigger and more crack resistant than Sun-Gold, which it was bred from. Indeterminate. 70 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Tomatillo

Cisineros Grande

Large fruits, up to 2 1/2", are easy to harvest and process. Highly productive. Most ripen to yellow, while some stay green. 4-6' plants. 85 Days 25 seeds



Cardinal Climber Vine

Ipomea sloteri. A beautiful, annual twining vine in the morning glory family, with vivid-crimson, trumpet-shaped flowers, that hummingbirds love. Attractive, emerald green foliage is shaped like palm leaves. Great for decks, arbors, posts, and trellises. Climbs to 10-15 ft. tall. Long bloom season. 30 seeds



Love-in-a-Mist

Nigella damascena

Profuse, blue blooms, surrounded by a cloud of feathery greenery, give way to purple streaked balloon pods. Great for cutting. Use fresh or dried. Direct seed in spring or start indoors. 18-24" 125 seeds



White Lace Flower

Orlaya grandiflora

2½- 3½" flowers with a lacy pattern. Well-branched plants with strong, upright stems are easy to grow and great for cutting. Clusters of green, star-shaped seed pods are nice in bouquets, too. 24-30" 200 seeds



Purple Millet

Pennisetum glaucum

3-5' plants have beautiful, deep purple, corn-like foliage and purple-black seed spikes, which can be a foot tall and an inch around. Use fresh or dried. Can grow in pots or in the ground. 95 Days 80 seeds



Romaine Lettuce

Cimmaron

An heirloom lettuce variety, Cimmaron produces loose, leafy heads of gorgeous red. Conical heads grow 10-12" tall, full of superb flavor and crisp, tender texture. Very resistant to bolting! 60 Days. 80 seeds



Oakleaf Lettuce

Italienischer

This lettuce is vigorous with bright green leaves. It can take some heat and is slow to bolt. Even at it's most mature size, this lettuce is sweet and crisp then others have become bitter in summer's heat. Upright, sturdy, full, 18" heads. 55 Days 80 seeds



Leaf Lettuce

Red Mix

A mix of several heirloom, red lettuce varieties, including Cimmaron, Outredgeous, and Red Sails. They all produce loose, leafy heads in many shades of red, with superb flavor and crisp, tender texture. All are bolt-resistant. 50-60 Days 80 seeds



Heirloom Winter Squash

Delicata

1-1½ lb. Ivory colored fruit, with dark green stripes, have unsurpassed sweetness. Many years of selection at Frosty Morning Farm. Stores well. 95 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Winter Squash

Gill's Golden Pippin

1-2 lb. Golden orange, acorn type fruit. Very sweet and flavorful, on productive vines. Stores very well. 85 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Winter Squash

Hidatsa

A delicious, very sweet squash said to have been a favorite of the Hidatsa people that live in what is now North Dakota. Pinkish-orange fruits range in size, from 5 to 10 lbs and make a great storage squash. 100 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Winter Squash

Tuffy Acorn

2 lb. Deep green colored fruit, with thick, rich, sweet, orange flesh. This variety is known for it's superb sweetness and smooth texture. Many years of selection at our farm. 90 Days 25 seeds



Heirloom Pie Pumpkin

Baby Pam

3-4 lb. smooth skinned, deep orange pumpkins have smooth, sweet flesh and make the best pies! Perfect, small pumpkins are great for kids and decorations, too. 100 Days 25 Seeds



Heirloom Pumpkin

Rouge vif D'Etampes

7-20 lb., wide, flattened, beautiful, red-orange fruits with deep ridges. Good eating pumpkin, great for soup cooked in the pumpkin! French heirloom. 100 days. 20 seeds
