## Heirloom Tomato

### Chadwick's Cherry

Tall, strong vigorous plants produce clusters of mouth watering 1" cherry tomatoes. Highly productive and disease resistant. A wonderful heirloom.

## Native Heritage Corn

### Painted Mountain

This vigorous, early, high yielding, native corn grows to 6' and produces 7-8", beautiful ears. Great for fall decorations and eating! It can be eaten fresh, roasted or dried and ground into cornmeal. It matures well in zone 4. 85 Days. 100 seeds



## Heritage Tomato

### Flaming Burst Pear/Cherry

Plants are loaded with 1 oz, split resistant, sweet, juicy, orange fruit. From the breeder of Green Zebra.

## Native Heritage Corn

### Montana Morado Maize

This striking, black flour corn grows well in short season areas. Its color makes it high in antioxidants. Besides being beautiful and useful for decorations, its soft kernels grind easily to make delicious cornbreads and polentas. 5-6' plants 8-10" ears

## Heritage Tomato

### Lucid Gem

These tomatoes are purple on top with red and orange bottoms. The insides of these lusciously flavored tomatoes are almost tie-dyed, with few seeds. A heavy producer, holding well on the vine and keeping well after harvest.

## Heirloom Gourd

### Tennessee Dancing Gourd

These plants have long vines and are prolific producers of 2-3" miniature bottle shaped gourds with green striping. They spin well, fresh or dried and can be used ornamentally and for crafts. Kids love them!

## Heirloom Tomato

### Gilbertie Paste

Long, slender, 7" heirloom fruits have rich flavored, meaty flesh and make excellent sauces and soups. Small seed cavity.

## Heirloom Tomato

### Chocolate Stripes

Tomato plants yield a plentiful crop of 3-4 inch, flattened, mahogany colored fruit with dark, olive-green striping and a delicious, complex, rich, sweet, earthy flavor.

## **Shelling Peas** **Miragreen**

4-5" pods with 8-10 plump, sweet peas. 4 foot productive vines. Hard to find heirloom variety being maintained at Frosty Morning Farm for many years. 68 days 80 seeds



## **Haudenosaunee Skunk** **Dry Pole Beans**

. Visually stunning heirloom grown by Haudenosaunee farming communities for many centuries. Very productive, vigorous vines that are well adapted to short growing seasons. Large, flat, black and white striped beans. 90 Days to dried. 50 seeds



## **Scarlet Emperor** **Runner Beans**

Growing to 6 feet, this 1735 heirloom pole bean, bears showy sprays of bright scarlet flowers loved by hummingbirds, followed by loads of slender pods about 8" long. Young pods can be used as snap beans, allowed to mature for a fresh shell bean, or dried for winter soups. 50-60 days 20 seeds



## **Summer Savory**

Summer Savory is a fragrant, hardy, bushy annual herb that goes well with a variety of foods. It's taste is peppery and minty, somewhat similar to thyme. The leaves are delicious fresh or dried. It is often grown as a companion plant with beans, since it helps keep away bean beetles. It does well in a container. 60 Days 70 seeds



## **Zucchini** **Costata Romanesco**

A sought after Italian heirloom, with gray-green skin and fluted edges. Flavor is rich, sweet and nutty. Much better flavor than hybrids. Excellent raw or cooked. Harvest small for best texture, but still delicious when bigger. Big, sprawling plant. 60 Days 20 seeds



## **Heirloom Tomato** **Ruth's Perfect**

Tall, strong, vigorous plants produce beautifully spherical, deep-red, 1/2 pound salad tomatoes with a delicious, fruity flavor. Keeps well after picking. Indeterminate 78 Days 25 seeds



## **Heritage Tomato** **Brad's Atomic Grape**

This is a delicious, sweet, productive tomato growing in clusters, with a plum shape. The color ranges from purple to green to red/brown with blue stripes. It holds well on the vine & after harvest. Indeterminate 75 Days 25 seeds



## **Heirloom Tomato** **Rose de Berne**

This Swiss heirloom produces good yields of medium-large fruit that are rose pink, and crack resistant. It's a great tasting tomato, with a perfect balance of acid and sweet. Indeterminate 75 Days 25 seeds



## **Heirloom Tomato** **Sungella**

2-3" wide orange globes with deliciously sweet flesh. Very productive and cold tolerant. Bigger and more crack resistant than Sun-Gold, which it was bred from.

Indeterminate 70 Days 25 seeds



## **Heirloom Paste Tomato** **10 Fingers of Naples**

Disease resistant plants produce long trusses (often numbering ten) of meaty fruits with rich flavor and few seeds. Great for sauce or salsa. Some Late Blight resistance.

## **Heirloom Ground Cherry** **Goldie**

Bushy plants in the tomato family, grow 2.5-3' tall, loaded with sweet, tropical-tasting gold berries wrapped in paper husks. When ripe, the husk turns papery dry and the fruits fall to the ground. A tarp can be placed on the ground, but the husk keeps them clean either way. 75 days 25 seeds



## **Cardinal Climber Vine**

*Ipomea sloteri*. A beautiful, annual, twining vine in the morning glory family, with vivid-crimson, trumpet-shaped flowers, that hummingbirds love. Attractive, emerald green foliage is shaped like palm leaves. Great for decks, arbors, posts, and trellises. Climbs to 10-15 ft. tall. Long bloom season. 30 seeds



## **Purple Millet** **Pennisetum glaucum**

3-5' plants have beautiful, deep purple, corn-like foliage and purple-black seed spikes, which can be a foot tall and an inch around. Use fresh or dried. Can grow in pots or in the ground. 95 Days ~60 seeds



## **Heirloom Kale** **Red Russian**

Blue-green leaves with wavy margins have red stems. Originating in Siberia, it is very hardy, but always has tender leaves that are mild and sweet, and can be used raw or cooked. The vigorous plant grows 18-36". 29 days baby, 50 full grown. ~50 seeds



## **Leaf Lettuce** **Hyper Red Ruffled Wave**

This lettuce has very dark red, wavy, savoyed leaves, that will catch your favorite salad dressing. It is cold hardy for spring and fall plantings. It was bred by Frank Morton, and has romaine in it's parentage. 50 Days 60 Seeds



## **Heirloom Winter Squash** **Blue Ballet**

A smaller version of Blue Hubbard, this squash has blue-gray skin and sweet, smooth, orange flesh, averaging 4-6 lbs. It yields and stores well.

## **Heirloom Winter Squash** **Delicata**

1-1 1/2 lb. Ivory colored fruit, with dark green stripes, have unsurpassed sweetness. Many years of selection at Frosty Morning Farm have perfected this delicious squash. Stores well.

## **Heirloom Winter Squash** **Potimarron**

This French heirloom has productive vines, bearing 2-5 lb., teardrop shaped squash with rich, chestnut flavored, orange flesh. It's great for soups, pies & savory dishes and it stores very well.

## **Heirloom Pie Pumpkin** **Baby Pam**

3-4 lb. smooth skinned, deep orange pumpkins have smooth, sweet flesh and make the best pies! Perfect, small pumpkins are great for kids and decorations, too.

## **Heirloom Pumpkin** **Rouge vif D'Etampes**

7-20 lb., wide, flattened, beautiful, red-orange fruits with deep ridges. Good eating pumpkin, great for roasting and for soup cooked in the pumpkin! French heirloom. Stores well, too!
